The fund attorney briefly reviewed the following proposed legislation: S797 (broadens and further defines terms under New Jersey's Conscientious Employee Protection Act "CEPA"), S905 (would amend the tort claims act to clarify that punitive damages may not be awarded against a public entity/employee acting within scope of employment), A387 (School Bus Safety and Child Protection Act), A531 (would clarify under OPRA records custodians would not be subject to penalties if they exercise due diligence in performing duties under the act), S1340 (would establish the NJ Bleacher Safety Act and require stricter safety standards at all places of public accommodation), A 527 (would require districts that maintain and AED adopt a policy concerning the use of the defibrillator), and A896 (would amend the penalties for a school bus driver who has left children on the school bus at end of route).
